Module Purpose

This module provides the learner with the knowledge and skills to climb and work at height on transmission powerline tower structures using the attached climbing method

This module can be used for both refresher and initial training

- For all workers required to climb and work at height on transmission powerline tower structures
- Frequency Annual

Summary of content

- Visual inspection and attachment of equipment
- Correctly ascending a tower
- Correctly descends a tower

Demonstrate correct visual inspection of equipment

- Perform visual inspection of harness, lanyards, and associated fall prevention devices
- Perform check for correct operation of fall prevention devices

Demonstrate correct attached climbing techniques

Demonstrate tower ascent with one lanyard always attached to an acceptable anchor point

Demonstrate correct attachment of pole strap or both lanyards when in final work position

Demonstrate the skill required to move to different work locations on the tower whilst attached at all times

Demonstrate correct descent of the tower with one restraining lanyard attached to an acceptable anchor point at all times

- Refresher 3 hours
