

UETDRRF05B PERFORM RESCUE FROM SWITCHYARD STRUCTURES AT HEIGHTS



COURSE OBJECTIVES

This course covers the initial and refresher training of an individual's knowledge and skills in the safe performance of rescue procedures from switchyard structures at heights in the workplace. It specifies the requirements of rescue from switchyard structures and how they apply in the context of transmission or distribution work functions. It encompasses responsibilities for health, safety and risk management processes at all operative levels and adherence to safety practices as part of the normal way of doing work.
